

# Terms of Participation

These participation requirements regulate the legal relationship between the participants of the Danube Cup II (3rd August until 5th August 2018) and the Austrian Canoe Federation (abbr. „OKV“) as organizer. All kinds of changes will be announced by the organizer on the homepage [www.kanuverband.at](http://www.kanuverband.at) or via E-Mail and these modifications will immediately become part of the current terms of participation. The organizer is the Austrian Canoe Federation, Berggasse 16, 1090 Wien. The place of jurisdiction is Vienna. The participation requirements have to be signed on-site.

## I. General

- (1) By registering for the Danube Cup II as well as by paying the participation fee every participant recognizes the terms of requirements.
- (2) Any kind of change of participant data can be done during the team leader meeting. Subsequent corrections or modifications are not permitted.
- (3) All participants aged 16 years or older are officially entitled to participate at the Danube Cup II Vienna. All participants below the age of 18 years require the official permission of a parent, legal guardian or their team leader.
- (4) The participants acknowledge, that the participation at the competition is at one's own risk and the organizer is not liable for neither accidents nor any further unforeseen happenings or damages before, during or after the event (including damages on or caused by any third parties).
- (5) The organizer reserves the right to disqualify participants, in case any incorrect data had been provided at the registration or in case of an existing ban being imposed by any national sport federation or the WADA (World Anti-Doping Agency).
- (6) The mandatory usage of the provided bib is required for the identification of the participants. A transfer of the bib to a third-person is not permitted. The participation without bib is leading to an immediate disqualification. Furthermore, it is forbidden to exchange, modify or pass the bib to other persons. Any breach of rules results without exception in an immediate disqualification.

## II. Liability

- (1) No alternative location is provided for the competition. The organizer reserves the right, to cancel the event immediately in case of any imminent danger or other fundamental reasons. In case of force majeure, for example flooding, storm, earthquake, act of terrorism, etc. the event will be canceled. Any paid participation fee cannot be reclaimed in such cases.
- (2) Furthermore, in case of delayed arrival or further reasons being caused by the participants themselves, participants are not entitled to receive any special treatments by the organizer nor reclaim the participation fee or any compensation for damages. Any expenses related to the arrival, departure or accommodation do not get refunded by the organizer.
- (3) The organizer is not providing any insurance coverage for medical treatments of the participants. Any liability related to expenses caused by medical treatments (including related costs, such as transportation and hospitalization) is explicitly excluded.
- (4) The organizer is not taking any liability for any health-related risks of the participants. The participants themselves are responsible to check their individual health condition in advance with medical support.
- (5) In addition, appropriate clothing and equipment as well as an adequate physical condition is mandatory to participate in the competition.

### **III. Safety Condition**

- (1) The participation at the Danube Cup II is subject to all regulations and requirements of the International Canoe Federation (ICF). The participants hereby obligate themselves to strictly comply with those regulations and requirements.
- (2) Participants have to obey all instructions given by the organizing team, security guards and the emergency medical services without exceptions. The organizer reserves the right, to reject registrations or exclude participants from the competition. The general doping safety regulations apply to the event without exceptions.
- (3) Persons suffering (but not limited to) illnesses related to the brain, the nervous system (e.g. epilepsy), the cardiovascular system or injuries and illnesses related to the musculoskeletal system must not participate in the event.
- (4) Intoxicated persons, or persons being evidently affected by drugs as well as persons, who are endangering themselves or other persons through their behavior or their condition are excluded from the participation.

### **IV. Protection of data privacy**

- (1) The data being collected from the participants at the registration get used by the organizer for the execution and the organizational processing of the event. Therefore, the data is being digitally stored and used. The data will be transferred to commercial third parties (such as Mojstrana Timing), for measuring the race time as well as to create result lists and to publish those lists on the internet. Through the online registration the participants agree to the digital storage of their data.
- (2) Last name, first name, date of birth, nationality, place of residence, gender, club, bib and the ranking of the participants will get printed and published across all relevant media channels in order to represent participation- and result lists. Through the registration the participants agree to the publication and the usage of any individual-related data.
- (3) The participants agree, that any kind of pictures, video shoots and audio recordings which are taken of them in relation to the participation at the event may be distributed and published without their consent and without receiving any compensation. Furthermore, the participants agree, that their data might be used for commercial purposes related to events and might get transferred to the Austrian and International press.
- (4) The participants are allowed to dissent to the transfer of individual-related data corresponding to paragraph (1) until (3) via letter or E-Mail ([office@kanuverband.at](mailto:office@kanuverband.at)).
