

Location

Regatta Course

The Regatta Course and technical facilities will be on a high standard. It is a 4-lane regatta course.

Boats

The Event Organisers will provide IDBF standard boats for teams entered.

Paddles

The Event Organisers will provide IDBF Spec 202a plastic Paddles, own Paddles are allowed with the same license.

Personal safety

All paddlers are expected to be able to swim 50m in light clothing unaided or as a minimum be water competent in cold water. All experienced International paddlers will not be required to wear a life jacket. Crews compete entirely at their own risk and must be "Fit to Race" under the IDBF Competition Regulations.

Insurance

We raise your attention to make sure that everyone has his/her own personal insurance with sport activity supplement!

Training

One training is included in the entry fee. This can be booked until 31.8.2020.

A separate rating will only take place from a minimum number of 3 clubs per category.


The Rules governing the number of Racers in a Crew:

Standard Boat

Due to the current situation of COVID-19, only crews with 10+2 paddlersare allowed. They start in a standard boat with a specified seating arrangement.

All Crews competing in the race will normally consist of a minimum of 8 and a maximum of 10 paddlers plus a Helm and Drummer, giving a minimum total of 10 and a maximum of 12 Racers in a boat.

Reserve Competitors up to a maximum of 2 may be nominated for each Crew and may compete without further reference to the Competition Committee provided that their names are shown on the submitted Crew List.



Mixed Crew

The number of Paddlers participating in the Mixed Class is a minimum of 4 and a maximum of 5 of either gender an in the.

Women Crew

The Drummer and Helm must also be a woman.













Funrace - Sturmbootrennen

Explanation

The team has to sit in the boat and temporarily drink a two liter bottle of "Sturm" (= new wine with a little bit alcohol) or "Traubensaft" (= new wine without alcohol).

Then the team goes to the start as usual and make a race over 200m.

Category

Mixed - 8 people, including at least 2 women Women - 8 Women

Race mode

depends on the entries received

The result is a combination of drinking time and driving time.

Paddles

The Event Organisers will provide IDBF Spec 202a plastic Paddles, own Paddles are not allowed.

Entry Fee

Participants in the 5th Vienna Dragon Boat Festival pay € 100 per team.

Companies and participants who only participate in the funrace pay € 300,-.

If there are teams that participate in the 5th Vienna Dragon Boat Festival and only want to come to the goulash soup dinner, there will be a flat rate of € 100 for 10 people.

Included

Participation and goulash soup for 10 people are included in the entry fee. In addition, the company or team can distribute advertising and goodies throughout the event area.


